## Innovate with AFRL

Doolittle Institute, in collaboration with the Air Force Research Lab Munitions Directorate (AFRL/RW) hosted the first annual "Innovate with AFRL" event to engage with small and non-traditional businesses and universities.

The content of this event was tailored for industry practitioners with limited or no experience working with AFRL/RW and was intended to provide an overview of the technological areas of interest at AFRL/RW as well as the key departments involved in furthering R&D relationships with industry.

Topics covered included: RW Science and Technology priorities, RW Technology Integration Priorities and RW SBIR/STTR Program Overview. The event concluded with an in-person networking session where industry was able to engage one-on-one with RW personnel.
